

TRAINING WORKSHOP IN ALWAR

Objective:

The objective of the workshop was to conduct capacity building training with 25 women sochnapreneurs so that they could understand the vision and mission of the programme.

Target Audience:

The workshop was conducted with 25 women Sochnapreneurs belonging to 25 different villages of block Ramgarh, Laxmangarh, Umrain and Kishangarh in Alwar district, Rajasthan.

Date:

The workshop was held on 2nd May 2018

Time:

The workshop was from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM

Venue:

It was conducted in B-121(A), Rath Nagar, near Hasan Khan Tempo stand, Alwar



Materials required:

All the women Sochnapreneurs were supposed to bring one case story each along with the photograph.

Activities carried out:

The workshop was conducted by the resource persons mentioned above. Different activities were undertaken to engage and educate the women sochnapreneurs present in the workshop.

1. The first activity was based on the process of creating revenue registers. All the women sochnapreneurs were told about the process of making revenue registers. They were told about the important points that need to be kept in mind while creating the registers. Further, they were also trained about the process of sending revenue details every month.

2. The second activity was to teach them about the process of conducting surveys. This activity was explained to them in different steps so that they could conduct the surveys systematically.

3. They were also informed about the work “sochnapreneur” does on daily basis. They were also motivated to carry forward the work of sochnapreneur enthusiastically.

4. Fourth activity was based on instructing the women sochnapreneurs regarding the format of writing the case stories.

5. After instructing them about the format of case stories, the resource persons gave them general training about operating the computer and its different functions.

6. Lastly, the workshop was converted into an open forum where all the women sochnapreneurs shared the problems they face while operating the Meraapp and then the solutions were further provided by the resource persons conducting the workshop.



Conclusion:

The workshop concluded with the point that the activities done in the training will be followed up in the next workshop which will be based on the second phase of “Sochnapreneur” programme.
