Introduction

On 24th Feb 2018, Digital Empowerment Foundation in partnership with Qualcomm launched the women Soochnapreneur initiative. The program was started by registering the names of the women soochnapreneur. Ibtada, a non-profit organization working for women empowerment for the last 20 years in Alwar also extended its support in this initiative. Most of the women were selected as soochnapreneur. They were the leaders of the self-help groups formed by Ibtada.



Honorable guests of this event were Mr. Pradeep, Block development officer of Ramgarh and Mr. Rajesh Singhi, Executive Director.







A brief overview of SoochnaPreneur Project and Mera App was shared with the soochnapreneurs. Tablets were also distributed to the women SPs by the Guests.

After the distribution of the tablets, Mr.Pradeep (B.D.O Ramgarh) motivated the women SPs to work for their community in a responsible manner and work for the betterment of the village/panchayat. Mr.Singhi also shared his views on the women SPs. He also encouraged women SPs to work with enthusiasm and zeal to make the information and the benefits of the entitlements accessible to the needy.

25 trainee soochnapreneur which included 5 ASHAs were then divided into 4 groups for the MeraAPP training. For this exercise, all the groups were supported by one experienced SP who have been doing the soochnapreneur work the last two years along with the DEF staff.



Mera App training Session 1 :-

Women got their Mera App ID and logged in their tablets. Then they learned how to do registration in Mera App. Women also got knowledge about other uses of Mera App like-how to find schemes how to add revenue, how to link the registered beneficiary with the schemes and how to sync data.

Mera App training Session 2 :-

This session started after lunch. Trainees were asked to do 5 registration and were also told to link the schemes on their own. The needed guidance was provided by the DEF staff and experienced SP.





At the end, vote of thanks was given to all the participants for attending the event and making it successful.
